Dear Brother Károly,

On behalf of ITUC Pan-European Regional Council, having affiliation of 90 national trade unions confederations, I would like to express our solidarity to the Hungarian workers and trade unions opposing the recent anti-employee proposals to the Hungarian Labour code.

We believe that policy for improvement of competitiveness cannot be based on deterioration of working conditions and cutting workers' rights disregarding international norms and values of social welfare state. On behalf of 90 trade union centers in Europe, we are strongly protesting against the arbitrary amendment to the Hungarian Labour Code aimed at establishing a six days working week by increasing the overtime threshold of 400 hours/annum and establish a time-frame of 36 months.

PERC calls the Hungarian Government and the legislators to vote against these changes and align with international standards and express its full solidarity with the Hungarian workers and their Unions in their fight for decent working and employment conditions and for democracy both in the society and in the world of work.
